ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The entry requirements for all Higher National Diploma (HND) Programmes are as follows:

1. Candidates are required to possess National Diploma in their chosen programme from any recognized/accredited Polytechnic or Monotechnic.
2. Candidates are also to possess at least five (5) relevant O'level credit passes including English Language and Mathematics at not more than two sittings in WAEC/NECO or NABTEB (O'level Examinations).
3. Candidates are required to have at least one year or two years post National Diploma Industrial Training Experience.

For details on the entry requirements peculiar to each of the Higher National Diploma (HND) programme, candidates should visit the Polytechnic website www.fpno.edu.ng.

It is also important to **NOTE** that candidates with pass level in National Diploma from institutions other than Federal Polytechnic Nekede are not qualified to apply and any false data entry during the on-line registration will lead to disqualification of the candidates at any time such is discovered.

METHOD OF APPLICATION

1. All candidates **MUST** first go to the school portal www.fpno.edu.ng, and click on "Application link" on the home page under students. Depending on your interest, choose either HND or ND to proceed.
2. Fill your Bio-data in the form and generate an invoice, print or copy out the invoice number, (you can do this on your mobile phone).
3. Proceed to **Federal Polytechnic Nekede Microfinance Bank** or any bank of your choice and make a payment of (**₦10,000.00**) Ten Thousand Naira only on **Remita** platform, Account No. **0140468461017**, using your invoice number. You can also choose to make your payment using your VERVE, VISA or MASTER CARD. If you choose the card payment option, you will be asked to fill the card details for the payment to be processed immediately.
4. Return to the school portal www.fpno.edu.ng, and complete your application process. Submit your data as requested and print out your acknowledgment slip. If you process your payment using your card, you will return to the portal immediately to print your receipt and acknowledgment slip.

5. All Application procedures MUST be completed on or before 12 midnight of 30th November, 2021.

Applicants can start and complete this process from any location in the country. It is therefore advisable to minimize trips to Owerri for the purpose of completing the form.
